Clair M. Harpole, 58, 137 S. E. 17th avenue, a veteran of the Mexican border clashes and World War I, died Tuesday at the United States Veterans hospital. He had been confined for several months with a heart ailment.

Funeral services will be at 1 p. m. Friday at A. J. Rose & Son funeral home with interment in Willamette national cemetery.

Mr. Harpole, an ex-baseball player and employed at the Portland baseball park, was born in Amity in 1893.

He served with Battery A, 147th field artillery. He was a member of the Rose City post No. 35, American Legion, and the Building labor union No. 296.
